Lodgings are comfortably rustic, with gender-specific cabins, shared shower facilities, and rooms that sleep four to six.

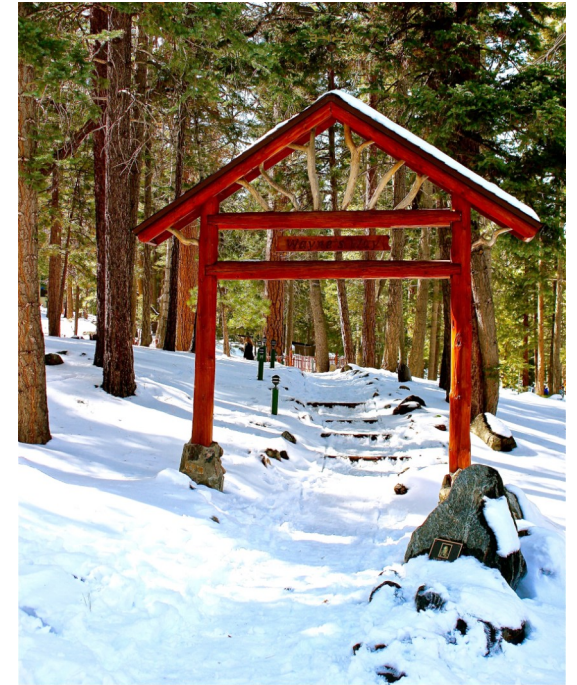
Delicious hot meals are prepared and served in Homet lodge, with vegan, vegetarian, and gluten-free options available upon request.
