Flying Information

You will want to fly into San Luis Obispo County Regional Airport (SBP). Three passenger airlines serve the airport with nonstop flights to eight cities: Dallas-Fort Worth, Denver, Los Angeles, Phoenix, Portland, San Diego, San Francisco and Seattle. Alaska Airlines, American Airlines and United Airlines service this airport.

Train Information

The train to San Luis Obispo offers a convenient and stress-free travel experience with stunning views of the Pacific Coast! The Amtrak Station in San Luis Obispo offers daily train service by the Coast Starlight and Pacific Surfliner. As an added bonus, the San Luis Obispo train station is within walking distance of downtown.
