Following an esteemed career in commercial, wall, and object art, Susan’s work now consists of alcohol inks and line work. Her influences and inspiration span from flowers to abstract to Picasso. As we were relegated to our homes, Susan committed to create one painting or drawing every day.

Her Atmo-sphere collection consists of embellished and adorned orbs, creating exquisite decor pieces with curio: vintage jewelry, and ornament. These pieces take well over 100 hours of sourcing, placing, and attaching the accoutrements to their surfaces. Each ball is one of a kind.

Susan also works in collage, featuring imagery of flowers, animals, architecture, and anatomy, the sky’s the limit.
