Directions to Camp de Benneville Pines

September 29, 2025

Due to a storm in mid-September, which caused a lot of road damage, Highway 38 through Redlands is CLOSED to camp.

To get to camp, all traffic will be diverted through Highland up the 330 and through Big Bear. Please plan for at least an extra 45 minutes of travel time.

Please download and print these directions and keep them handy with you in the car because cell service can be spotty in the mountains.

- Plan your route to begin on Highway 330 in Highland at the bottom of the mountain and the 210 Freeway
- Follow Highway 330 and in Running Springs head toward Big Bear
- Once at the dam, stay left onto Highway 38/North Shore Drive all the way to North
 Division Drive (you will be following along the lake, which will be on your right side)
- Turn Right on Division Drive (This route avoids all the traffic to get through the tourist part of Big Bear)
- Turn left on Big Bear Blvd and keep going all the way to camp
- Upon getting to the east end of Big Bear Blvd, there is a sign that says TO REDLANDS. This is the way to go. This is Highway 38 and from this point it is another 20 minutes to camp
- You may encounter a manned road closure sign at Lake Williams Road. Let the monitor know you are attending an event at Camp de Benneville Pines in Barton Flats.
- IMPORTANT: Continue PAST Jenks Lake East and keep going a few miles to Jenks
 Lake West and then turn left
- Follow this road to camp as usual
- We will be on the right 1 1/2 miles up the road
- NOTE: If you turn left onto Jenks Lake East by mistake, you will make it to camp but remember from this direction camp will be on your left, and it will be a longer drive on Jenks Lake East
